Institutional Distinctiveness: -

Nandurbar Taluka Vidhayak Samiti was established in 1961. Nandurbar is situated near the Tribal belt of Satpuda Ranges. No educational facilities were available to the Tribal as well as other students in the nearby area. The founder Chairman Late G. T. Patil alias Bapuji had a great vision and did every effort to enlarge the educational facilities for the youth from deprived classes. Within a few years Nandurbar Taluka Vidhayak Samiti flourished like a huge tree and now running 64 branches from primary to higher education. The said institution was established in 1970 and it was a notable event for Nandurbar Taluka Vidhayak Samiti to have an Educational College in such a small place like Nandurbar for 52 years. It was previously affiliated with the University of Pune. The 1.82 hectares campus of Nandurbar Taluka Vidhayak Samiti where the said institution is located is aloof from town and free from pollution which always inspires the students to study and progress.

The institution made various facilities available to students like a multipurpose hall, ladies' and gents' hostel, common gymnasium, playground, vehicle parking shed, and a few recreational facilities. The institution is an old and well-known institution in Kavayitri Bahinabai Chaudhari North Maharashtra University.

The institution has a well-equipped library from where the students get books as well as teaching aids, Book bank facility is available to all students. The institution has consistently maintained a record of high merit. The institution is keen on the all-round development of the trainees. The principal Dr. M. S. Raghuwanshi, Dr. N. G. Vasave, Dr. D. While pre-practice teaching programs and practice teaching program start, special feedback is provided to them and they are motivated towards quality teacher training programs. Emphasis is given to building their confidence and how they will come into the mainstream. Such practice is being implemented for the last 52 years. 
